

## Ares Reserves Faculty Instructions

Instructors can access the Ares Reserves software by going to <https://reserves.lib.wvu.edu/> or by going to the “Course Reserves” page under “Services” on the Libraries’ homepage.

**Logon to Ares using your WVU logon and password.** Once logged in, on the left side of the page you will see the following menu:

- **Switch to Student Mode:** Enables instructors to see the student view of the course
- **Main Menu:**
  - **Awaiting Supply by Instructor** table (*this will only appear if the instructor has said they will bring a personal copy to the library for Reserves*)
- **Instructor Tools**
  - **Previous Courses:** Instructors can view their past courses and items (this will not be available until a history of classes has been created in Ares)
  - **Upcoming Courses:** Displays courses from the current semester. Toward the end of each semester, it will included classes from the following semester.

In the middle of the page, there is an image similar to that shown below. To see what materials are on reserves for a current class, click on the link “View Course” in the left-hand column by the course number.
